EXPLANATION OF FEES

NEW STUDENT APPLICATION FEE: This fee is required of all new applicants. This is for setting up and opening a new student application on Facts. The fee includes any necessary testing fees. **Application fees are non-refundable.**

ENROLLMENT FEE: This annual fee is required for enrollment and/or re-enrollment. Enrollment fees cover student accident insurance, school supplies, and miscellaneous assessments. Returning students can enroll at a discounted rate if completed prior to posted deadlines. **Enrollment fees are non-refundable.**

TUITION: Used for faculty and staff salaries, facilities upkeep, property note and other operational expenses. Tuition can be paid in-full or monthly over 10 months (July - April).

ACTIVITIES FEE: Used for purchase of textbooks and workbooks (elementary), testing costs, bus use, maintenance, fuel, insurance for field trips, arts and crafts supplies, some labs and classroom expenses. **This is a required fee and will be billed through Facts.**

TECHNOLOGY FEE: Annual fee to cover costs of apps, school-wide filters for student devices including phones, iPads, classroom technology, and technology improvements. **This is a required fee and will be billed through Facts.**

SENIOR FEE: Fee applied to high school seniors to off-set cost of cap and gowns, graduation, and other senior related expenses.

WITHDRAWALS: If withdrawing before the end of the school year, a withdrawal fee will be charged. Before any records are released, all fees and balances must be paid in full. No refunds will be given on tuition and fees paid prior to your withdrawal date.

OTHER LCS COSTS

TEXTBOOKS: Middle School and High School textbooks may be purchased by the school and charged to FACTS accounts.

CLASS OR LAB FEES: Some classes may have an additional fee associated with the class for the purchase of additional lab or hands on materials. This mostly occurs with science and electives.

ADMINISTRATION FEE: A \$30 monthly processing fee (\$300 yearly) will be charged to anyone not using FACTS or paying tuition outside of FACTS.

ATHLETIC FEES: Athletic fees help pay coaches' stipends, league fees, officiating expenses, team equipment, uniform purchases, and some facility expenses. **Athletic fees are required to participate in athletics.**

YEARBOOK FEE: Purchase of the LCS Yearbook. Prices increase throughout the year. **Yearbooks are optional.**

MORNING CARE: Morning Care is available beginning at 7:00am. The cost is \$5 per day, per child.

AFTERSCHOOL CARE: "Aftercare" (K-8th grade) is available until 6:00pm. Fees are announced at the beginning of school year. A surcharge will be applied after 6:00pm.

RETURNED CHECKS: Returned checks are subject to a \$25.00 per item fee, electronic corrections or adjustment fees will be assessed on your next statement.

LATE FEES: Tuition payments received 30 days late will be subject to a \$25.00 per student late fee, payments received 60 days late will be subject to a \$50.00 per student late fee, payments received 90 days late will be subject to a \$100.00 per student late fee. If any account is 120+ days late, students will be removed from school until account is brought current.

STUDENT RECORDS: Student records are the property of Lee Christian School and will not be released until all accounts are paid in full.

AVAILABLE TUITION DISCOUNTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

EARLY ENROLLMENT DISCOUNT: Currently enrolled families that are returning who pay registration fees prior to April 15 will receive discounted registration fees.

NORTH CAROLINA OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIPS: Eligible students in K-12th grade may qualify for North Carolina scholarship of up to \$5,928 a year to attend Lee Christian School.
