



Middle & High School Dress Code

Tops

Lee Christian t-shirt, Polo, or collared shirt of any color. (LCS logo is not required on Polos or collared shirts).

Shirts must fit neatly and modestly.

All t-shirts MUST be Lee Christian School t-shirts.

Bottoms

Properly fitting* jeans, uniform-style pants, or properly fitting* uniform style shorts (length should fall somewhere between mid-thigh to just below knees).

Girls may also wear modest** skirts (length should fall somewhere between mid-thigh to just below knees).

Leggings may be worn only with skirts.

Outerwear

Jackets, hoodies, and sweaters must be properly fitting.*
Acceptable hoodies include:

- LCS spirit wear
- College, university, or military academy
- Church or faith-based

New rule coming for 2025-2026 school year: Hoodies may ONLY be LCS hoodies.

Shoes

Shoes must be closed-toe/closed back or strap on the heel. No Crocs.

Hats, Caps, & Head Coverings

Head coverings may be worn while outside, but they are not allowed while students are in the buildings.

Hair

Must be kept clean with no extreme, unnatural hair color or styles.

Make Up

Girls may wear make up. It must be kept modest, natural looking, and not distracting.

PE Dress

Students must purchase and wear a LCS PE uniform. Ordering information will be sent home to parents. Students are required to change into normal uniform clothing at the end of their PE class.

Chapel Dress

Students may dress above/nicer than normal dress code on Wednesdays only.

Boys may wear dress shirts, and girls may wear dresses and/or skirts. All clothing must still abide by our modesty** standards.

*Properly fitting is defined as neither too tight nor too loose, fitting at the waist, and without holes, tears, or patches.

**Modest is defined as appropriate length & fit; not skin-tight, see-through, or too revealing.

Free Dress & Spirit Days

From time to time, students will be rewarded with free dress days, including spirit days when students are encouraged to follow themes. Students are expected to adhere to proper LCS modesty standards.

Dress Code Infractions

For the first dress code infraction, a parent will be contacted to bring appropriate attire. If a parent is unable to come to school, student may not return to class. Student will complete class assignments in front office. After five infractions, student will be dismissed from LCS.
